

ESG SERVICE SPECIFIC LICENSING TERMS

Additional Definitions:

“Core User” means any User other than a Stakeholder.

“Stakeholder” means: ESG - A Stakeholder is a limited user that can submit, access, and respond to ESG requests (such as metrics data collection) and view and remediate issues.

“ESG Data Collection Workflows” means a process that enables metric data to be collected and reviewed.

“ESG Topics” refers to each page dedicated to the detailed topic or impact areas of the ESG pillar, such as climate change, human capital, or corporate governance.

“ESG Metrics” refers to each page dedicated to the data, metrics, and criteria used to track and assess ESG performance (included in various ESG Topics) such as employee volunteer hours, carbon impact of employee air travel, or employee safety records. Any converted metrics presented in ESG Metrics are based on User input. As a result, AuditBoard does not guarantee the accuracy or completeness of the information presented.

“ESG Framework” refers to a broader, contextual framework or standard, such as SASB or GRI. These frameworks include specific criteria or ESG metrics, for what should be reported on a particular topic such as public interest focus, independence, due process, and public consultation.

“Integration” means an external system or application to which AuditBoard connects.
